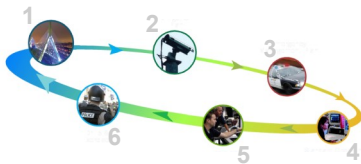
ICS 402 Incident Command System Overview for Executives
